Ten Tulsa Artists Open Doors for Art Studio Tour

TULSA - The Oklahoma Visual Arts Coalition's upcoming Tulsa Art Studio Tour will open the studio doors of 10 Tulsa artists in 8 studios. Visitors will get a passport to experience the creative process and meet the artists in their community April 10-11 from noon until 5 p.m each day.

Art fans will find the Tulsa Art Studio Tour a rare opportunity to see artists in their working space, talk with them about their creations, as well as view and buy artwork. The tour is self-guided and presented by the Oklahoma Visual Arts Coalition.

The artists work in a range of artistic media including photography, painting, ceramics, and more, representing a variety of stages in their art careers. Tour artists include:
