Video Intern Description:

The Oklahoma Visual Arts Coalition (OVAC) is seeking an intern to assist with production of online and/or video resources. OVAC is a non-profit organization that supports visual artists living and working in Oklahoma and promotes public interest in the arts.

OVAC seeks a special video intern to contribute inspiration, stories, and content to catalogs, blogs, social media, and sponsor packets. OVAC invites idealists and leaders who can put their thoughts and insights into action through video.

Commitment: Minimum three completed 3-5 minute video projects the span of one school semester. Deadlines will be set by OVAC staff and content will be subjective.

Duties include:

- Learning about OVAC's mission & programming and Oklahoma artists
- Participating in brainstorming sessions about new video projects
- Researching new uses of video marketing through social media, etc...
- Equipping and managing video shoots of events, artist profiles, and behind-the-scenes activities
- Need access to personal or academic editing software
- Compiling clips, editing and uploading footage online on regular deadlines
- Creative documentation of events
- May be requested to do non-video tasks for OVAC as needed

Ideal interns will:

- Have ability to work quite independently
- Be very reliable and responsive to working on a deadline
- Take direction to work autonomously, but also collaborate with others as part of a team
- Have strong and varied computer skills
- Communicate effectively on the phone, in person and in writing
